Develop safe and effective horsemanship skills together with other members of the Midwest Fjord Horse Club. These activities will be in conjunction with Combatant's Keep Treaty City Joust. MWFHC members will be able to learn and participate in medieval skill at arms (games).

Why: To encourage and develop a safe, supportive and educational based Fjord horse community in the Midwest.

Facility: The Darke County Fairgrounds has 3 riding arenas of 3 different sizes. There are also several drives up to the north end of the fairgrounds that make nice driving trails.

Food: There will be a food vendor on site.

Stalls: There are 170+ horse stalls available. There are outlets approximately every 3rd stall for fans, etc. There is also a 6-stall wash rack available for use.

Camping: There are water and electrical hookups available for \$25.00/night. There are restrooms with showers at the east end of the arenas.

Vendors: Vendors are welcome to set up for a fee of \$45.

Dogs: All dogs must be on a leash or caged at all times. It is a public area, so there will be other dogs on leashes walking through the area. Please be considerate of others with regard to your dog and its behavior. Please clean up after your dogs.

We have only 5 indoor stalls to rent. We have several fenced outdoor paddocks to rent. You are encouraged to set up your own outdoor fencing or stall panels and camp.

Camping

This will be **dry camping only**. Electricity will not be provided. We will do our best to provide you with enough space to be comfortable but camping real estate is limited.

Farm Trails

Mowed field trails on rolling gentle hills with a few marshy drainage ditch crossings that can have standing water at times. Forest trails will be marked. Expect a few exposed rocks and some muddy drainage crossings.

Burnett Country trails

Burnett county trails are maintained by the Cumberland Area Ski Touring Association for the Timberland Hills Cross country Ski Area. There are about 20 miles of trails on around 2000 acres that are about twenty feet wide. The terrain is rolling hills with some steep up and down hills. This country property is restricted to non-motorized foot travel only. Camping on the property is allowed. There is a vault toilet at the parking lot but no running water available. The trail head is located one mile from our farm on a dead-end gravel road.

Dogs: All dogs must be on leash or caged at all times. Our farm dogs will remain in their cage for the weekend. Barking dogs are not welcome. Please be considerate of others with regard to your dog and its behavior.

Helmets Mandatory

Our insurance policy requires that all people must wear a helmet while handling horses, riding a horse, driving a horse, or riding on a carriage on our property.
