SHOW COMMITTEE  
2/18/2006

The Executive Committee met with the Blue Earth show committee at 12:30 on 2/18/2006.

The NFHR rules were discussed. Pat Holland brought up the fact that we have our own set of show rules.

Pat handed out a list of classes for the summer show.

The Hospitality Committee was discussed. It was mentioned that perhaps it could be incorporated with the sales items. We will ask if anyone wants to do it and thank Guy and Martha for the great job they did last year. It will be announced at the general meeting that we have the Hospitality tent if anyone is interested in being in charge. Otherwise, we will not have one this year.

We will talk to Gary Johnson regarding some of the auction money being used for permanent improvements such as a round pen and a warm-up arena. We would have around \$3000 to spend.

There was discussion regarding changing the days of the show. It was decided to leave them as they are now.

The photographer was discussed. It was decided to ask Avalon Photography for the 2006 Blue Earth Show.

President Chuck Kelly spoke about the need for an additional loudspeaker in the warm-up arena. A Committee person will inform Marlin Krupp to call the show in the event of inclement weather. We could spend some of the auction proceeds on a new loudspeaker system.

There was discussion regarding the two white gates at the ends of the barn. They cannot be removed because they are closed at night. There is a dangerous latch on one of them. We will ask Gary Johnson to take the latch off or make it less dangerous.

The placement of the food vendors and the merchandise tent was discussed. They will be left as they were.

Prices were discussed for the Blue Earth Show. It was decided to leave them the same as before.

Rich Hotovy stated that someone should tell the judge what we are looking for before the show starts. He would like to see all hitch classes enter the arena at a trot. The farm hitch this year will be one unit that all exhibitors will use.
