There will be a half hour meeting at Blue Earth on Monday morning at 8:30. This will be for anyone who has questions and did not ask them at the general meeting.

The ballots will be counted Sunday afternoon.

Trophies for the show were discussed.

Chuck will propose an amendment to the bylaws at the summer meeting to shorten the 90 day voting to 45 days. He will suggest using specific dates in the by laws.

Patti Jo will write up an agenda for the summer meeting and put it in the tidbits.

There was discussion regarding submission of budgets. There should be a budget submitted by the winter meeting committee and also the show committee.

Discussion regarding the NFHR rules. There will be a committee set up to work on this. There will be two people who want the rules passed and two people who do not want the rules passed on the committee. A synopsis of their findings will be sent to the membership by mail and voted on by ballot.

It was suggested to put on the summer agenda a discussion of having a promotions committee for next year.
