There have been several youth classes added to the Blue Earth show line up.

There will be a new high point driving award grand and reserve this year in Blue Earth.

Patti Jo will purchase items for the high point awards and Susie Sadlon will purchase items for the other awards.

The Faribault County Fair Board has agreed to allow the Club to charge \$3 per class this year as was charged 25 years ago. All of that money will go to the fair board and none of it to the Club.

Dawn Schlickman will honor the founding members of the Club at the Tuesday night show in the grandstand.

Becky from Horse'N Around magazine will give us two free banners with the sponsor's names on them. If we need an additional one, we will purchase another one.

Therine will prepare a note to add to each trophy requesting that the winner send a thank you note to the sponsor for that class.
